

Hedonistic is the appropriate word while sipping Aspire, and will culminate a pleasant symmetry and luxury now, and over the next 6 years.."



Opulent and full textured, French oak accentuates the mouthfeel, but is never dominant. This togetherness combines the lovely floral aromatics of Grenache with the savory structure of Cabernet. Audacious is begging to be enjoyed and will reward cellaring of around 4-6 years of release."
